### Competition „Europäischer Gestaltungspreis 2022“

An art competition of the Landesinnung Baden-Württemberg for wood sculptors and the young talent wood sculptors on the theme of

> CURIOUS ABOUT TOMORROW <

When the Landesinnung started thinking about the motto for the „European Design Award 2022“, no one had imagined that a pandemic would turn our lives upside down for so long. Despite restraint and renunciation, hopefully we have learned to make the best of every day and to reconcile ourselves with the unexpected. The motto „CURIOUS ABOUT TOMORROW“ reflects this tension.

Woodsculptors chose their profession by passion. They have a high level of creativity, craftsmanship and sensitivity. So we encourage you to submit your work to show what can be conjured from wood. With your talent you will help to bring our wonderful craft to the attention of the public.

Your efforts will be rewarded: Awards totaling 16,000 EURO, donated by the Mittelsächsische Kultur gGmbH, by the company ANDREAS STIHL AG & Co. KG and the town of Lichtenstein/Sa. The Staatliche Toto-Lotto GmbH Baden-Württemberg supports with a donation.

### Who can participate

Sculptors and freelance wood sculptors from all over Europe.

Particularly invited to participate are:

- Members of the State Guild of Wood Sculptors in Baden-Württemberg,
- Members of the Wood Sculptors Association of Switzerland and
- Members of the Corporation des Sculpteurs sur Bois du Bas-Rhin.

The Young Artist Award is open to all people between 16 and 26 residing in an European country, who are training to become a wood sculptor or have completed their training, as well as students at art academies studying the subject of wood sculpture.

Participation is limited to one artwork (max. three years old, max 25 kg). It must not exceed the dimensions 115 x 35 x 35 cm. The main material is any type of wood, which must be processed with at least 66%.

## Application

### Application procedure

Please send your entry form with a photo of your work to the office of the Landesinnung der Holzbildhauer Baden-Württemberg in Freiburg (address overleaf). An original of your work is only required for competition stage II.

Closing date: **October 1, 2021 (date of postmark)**

### 2-stage evaluation procedure

Competition Stage I: All submitted works will be evaluated on the basis of the information contained in the entry documents. The best works will be passed to the next stage of the competition.

Competition stage II: All the works that reach this stage are exhibited. The winners will be selected from them.

### Exhibition and sale

The works will be exhibited in the spring of 2022 at the Regierungspräsidium Karlsruhe. They will then be presented at the Museum Rochsburg Castle near Chemnitz\* (for dates see overleaf).

A sale during the exhibition is possible. The Landesinnung receives 10% of the sales price of each work. Please take this into account when setting the price. In any case, the exhibit remains part of the exhibition until the end. During both exhibitions the works are insured.

### Delivery and collection

Delivery and collection (Karlsruhe in each case) are to be made at your own risk and for your own account.

The Landesinnung will organize the return shipment on request. Preconditions are: Packaging material must be provided at the time of delivery and a fee of 50.00 EURO must be paid before delivery of the artwork to the following account (there is no refund possible):

## Evaluation & Awards

### Evaluation criteria

The jury was composed of representatives of the art, craft, media and business communities. The decisions of the jury are final.

The main evaluation criteria are:

- Content statement
- Selection and use of materials
- Processing appropriate to the material, creative
- Technical, creative and artistic realization
- Overall impression

### Award ceremony

The awards will be presented at the opening ceremony of the exhibition:

Thursday, March 24, 2022 - 6 p.m. in Karlsruhe at the Regierungspräsidium, Meidingerhall
